### Footnotes

WAY DEVIOUS in the second flight from outside on the backstretch, was under a drive from path four on the turn, rallied under steady urging in the lane and got up in the final strides. TRICK RYDER was rated on the front end from inside, moved ahead when allowed on the turn, put to a drive with three-sixteenths left, drew clear, was outfinished but clearly second best. BUSHY GEORGE settled from outside, picked up his pace just off the inside on the turn, steadily closed the gap through the lane and took over third late. CHEROKEE ROLL disputed the pace just outside TRICK RYDER for a half mile, was no match for the latter after that and wore down between horses the final furlong. AIN'T NO BULL void of speed, saved ground on the turn, floated out some into the stretch and had no late bid. DART GUN was away a step slow, quickly moved up between horses to prompt the early pace, three wide on the turn then flattened out for the drive. STORM STROLLER steadily angled out on the backstretch, was widest taking the bend and proved unresponsive in the lane.
