**Footnotes**

PERFECT STRIKE shared the early lead between horses, came into the lane from path three, moved clear when asked and held off KID RAMBO under steady handling. KID RAMBO pressed the pace just outside PERFECT STRIKE from the early going, tried hard in the lane, could not close the gap but was easily second best. SUDDENLY a bit slow to start, advanced between horses, was three wide on the turn, fanned out to path five for the stretch run, took over third then could just maintain his position. VALERA ROYAL without speed toward the outside, angled in near the half mile pole, progressed from paths two or three to midstretch then finished evenly. WICKED FLYER displayed brief speed inside but faded leaving the turn and angled outside SNOWBOUNDALLKNIGHT midstretch. SNOWBOUNDALLKNIGHT dueled for the lead between horses, gained the rail on the turn and flattened out for the drive. EMPTY VAULT widest throughout, was not a factor.
