ROYAL REGENT settled off the inside, picked up his pace after a half mile, advanced three wide on the second turn, swung out widest into the lane, altered out to stay clear of CLAUDE H upper stretch, gained a slight advantage then gradually lugged in as he fought to hold on. CLAUDE H prominent from outside, went for the lead three wide on the second bend, had a slight advantage when he began to bear out upper stretch, was corrected, also gradually lugged in as he battled the last eighth but had to settle for second best. SECURITYSNIGHTMARE a bit slow at the start, was angled out early, four and five wide through the second turn, gained a striking position between rivals upper stretch but could only get third late. STORMY PAL settled and taken inside on the backstretch, saved ground taking the second turn, moved inside MARKET TREND upper stretch, threatened with a furlong to go but leveled off instead. MARKET TREND disputed the pace from inside, floated out a bit into the stretch and gradually wore down. PERFECT HEAT displayed early speed just outside MARKET TREND but also did not have enough left in the stretch and was drifting out late. IRISH MONARCH prominent between horses, gave way two wide on the second turn, was eased in the stretch and walked off. MR. SLY steadily faded from well off the inside, was pulled up inside the last furlong and also walked off.
