JENNA'S ROSE was sent clear, just off the inside on the bend, floated out a bit for the stretch run, gradually lengthened command and was put to a drive late. SHE'S TRUE CLASS in contention toward the outside, moved clear for second from path three on the turn, drifted out five wide entering the lane, was no match for the winner, began to wear down the final sixteenth and just held her position. V. S. H. TWO SHAY a brief contender from inside, saved ground taking the turn, lacked a significant stretch response but was unchallenged for third. STAR VALE could not stay close nearing the turn, dropped back further along the rail on the bend, swung five wide entering the lane, altered in as ODA came out with three-sixteenths left and advanced without threat. ODA an early factor between rivals, failed to stay close just off the inside on the turn, angled four wide into the stretch, moved out some with three-sixteenths to go and had no late bid. JARETT'S FOOL at the back and just off the inside, swung out seven wide for the drive and had little to offer. IN EXCESSIVE FLICK void of speed between horses, was three wide into the turn, fanned widest into the lane and was empty. LIL LINDA LU gradually progressed from outside, angled out six wide for a clear path entering the stretch then began to tire.
