Footnotes

PARTING GESTURE rated in the second flight from outside, commenced his bid four wide on the turn, took over second upper stretch, rallied under steady urging and swept past TORCH DOWN in the waning yards. TORCH DOWN shared the early lead two wide, moved clear leaving the turn, widened under a drive in the lane, was all out, did not have enough to hold off PARTING GESTURE but was easily best of the rest. MAGICNCOURT was soon far back, stayed well off the inside taking the bend, altered out twice as he made his bid in the lane and caught JELLYFISH LAKE for third nearing the wire. JELLYFISH LAKE without speed from inside, swung out five wide into the lane, took over third deep stretch but was outfinished. ONE BOUNCE CHECK was a brief contender between horses, angled in on the turn and had no late bid. RUBY'S SAINT displayed early speed inside, could not stay with TORCH DOWN leaving the turn and wore down the final furlong. MR. BRADY without early foot between horses, was three to five wide taking the bend then weakened for the drive.
