KID RAMBO raced within contention, came around the turn three wide, angled in down the stretch and proved no match for the top two. SANTO pressed the early pace and faded. SOONER BLUE lacked early speed, never raced near the front and was vanned off after the wire. SHOULDABEENINPICS always raced near the back, came around the turn three wide and showed little.
