Footnotes

ESPARTA (MEX) vied for the lead between horses from the beginning, did not stay with EARLY GIRL while three wide on the bend, rallied under urging upper stretch, took over inside the final furlong and held off FUNKY CHANTEAL. The latter disputed the pace from inside, backed up along the rail through the turn, began her rally at the top of the stretch, her rider lost his whip but she slowly closed the gap with hand urging the last eighth. EARLY GIRL dueled for the lead between horses, moved ahead two wide on the turn but slowly yielded deep stretch. SHOULD forwardly placed toward the outside on the backstretch, failed to stay close four and five wide taking the bend and ran evenly through the lane. MARIES FAST LADY prominent between horses early, retreated three wide on the turn. SHANNA SAVANA broke in the air, a good bit behind the rest, moved up from outside to be a contender nearing the end of the first quarter mile but faded widest on the turn.
