### Footnotes

TENNIS STAR rated from outside, picked up her pace nearing the second turn, was four wide approaching the quarter pole, forced to fan out to path six entering the lane, edged ahead upper stretch, gradually lugged in, could not pull clear from between rivals but held on under steady urging. SOARING SPIRIT closest to the pacesetters from outside, also commenced her bid into the second turn, was steadied briefly lacking a clear path at the quarter pole, swung five wide into the stretch and found best stride too late the final sixteenth. SUPER SWANK broke alertly, soon shared the lead inside her rival but off the rail, gradually moved to the rail through the second turn, drifted out entering the lane, moved back to the rail upper stretch, did not relent when she lost the advantage soon after but lacked the extra kick needed. KATIE'S PROSPECT was settled inside, angled out some for a clear path on the backstretch, was just off the rail on the second turn, checked solidly and altered out to stay clear of TRICK FALLS leaving that bend, lost considerable ground fanning to the middle of the track into the stretch, closed well but was too late. JARETT'S FOOL angled in beside SUPER SWANK on the first turn, shared the lead, was carried out by the latter into the stretch and slowly yielded. SHE'S WAY COOL gradually moved to the inside on the backstretch, picked up her pace on the second turn, was checked hard and narrowly squeezed through inside TRICK FALLS leaving the quarter pole, slowly made up ground in the lane and was angled out in the waning yards for a clear path. TRICK FALLS also gradually moved toward the inside on the backstretch, rushed up along the rail on the second turn, clipped SUPER SWANK'S heels at the quarter pole, the rider stayed on but lost his irons. TRICK FALLS was pulled up in the stretch and walked off. There was a stewards' inquiry into TRICK FALLS' problems leaving the second turn but no action taken after their review.
