Footnotes

SPEED KING rated from inside for more than a half mile, commenced his bid nearing the second turn, waited for room just off the rail, altered out four wide upper stretch for a clear path, rallied under a steady drive and got up in time. EVANSVILLE VAN settled, gradually advanced just off the rail on the backstretch, went for the lead three wide on the second turn, angled in some entering the stretch, moved clear, tried hard but did not have enough left. JAWBREAKER JACK bobbed a bit at the break, was settled, slowly progressed off the inside, swung out widest leaving the second turn, gradually closed the gap in the lane and caught SUPER SAPELLO for third in the waning yards. SUPER SAPELLO had his head turned when the gate opened, progressed from outside to threaten four wide on the second bend, also angled in some entering the stretch and slowly wore down inside the last eighth. GUILTBYASSOCIATION was quickly clear, engaged from outside on the backstretch, regained a clear lead when LEESTOWNS FINALE dropped out of it on the second turn but gradually weakened for the drive. LEESTOWNS FINALE moved up outside GUILTBYASSOCIATION to share the lead on the backstretch but gave way between rivals on the second turn, drifted out entering the stretch and continued to fade.
