Footnotes

OTILIO crowded and quickly altered out at the break, was settled and angled in, picked up his pace just off the inside through the bend, steadied briefly when his path narrowed at the head of the lane, got through two wide leaving the three-sixteenths marker, made a strong move under a steady drive and swept past GET UP TAYLOR in the waning yards. GET UP TAYLOR broke alertly, set a pressured pace just off the inside, moved clear midway on the bend, drifted out a bit upper stretch, was corrected, gradually lengthened his lead, was all out deep stretch, did not have enough nearing the wire but was clearly second best. CALL THE LAW prominent from inside, swung out to path three leaving the turn, found himself behind GET UP TAYLOR, altered in with three-sixteenths left, loomed a serious threat with a furlong to go but could not sustain his bid late. CORKED was an early contender between rivals, four and five wide taking the bend then lacked a stretch bid while widest. FLAPS raced in the second flight between horses on the backstretch, backed up three wide on the turn and gradually wore down for the drive. SUAVEY displayed early speed from outside, was three and four wide through the turn then flattened out in the lane. MR MYSTERIOUS was boxed in behind GET UP TAYLOR through the early going, got through along the inside leaving the turn but gave way in the stretch. BERNARDO STAR forwardly placed between rivals, gave way from outside on the bend.
