IRISH TITO shared the lead just off the inside, moved clear leaving the bend, drifted out to path four entering the lane, was challenged from inside upper stretch but shook off INDIES SPRING under a steady drive nearing the final sixteenth. INDIES SPRING forwardly placed from outside, angled in to be just off the rail on the turn, came to IRISH TITO from inside midstretch, no match for that one late but was unchallenged for the place. HEARING VOICES contested the pace from outside, just outside IRISH TITO on the turn, drifted out to path six into the lane, could not stay with the top pair as he drifted out some but maintained full control of third. NEEDANOTHERFEELING void of speed not far off the inside, was just off rail taking the bend, passed some tired ones upper stretch then finished evenly. BIT OF LUX in contention between horses early, drifted out some entering the turn, stayed well off the inside through the bend and was empty for the drive. BIG BRYCE steadied trying to avoid TANKA WINE at the start, was soon far back, just off the inside into the turn, floated out behind BIT OF LUX entering the stretch, moved inside that one near the eighth pole and had no late bid. W F WILDCAT was a brief factor inside but faded leaving the turn. TANKA WINE put his head down nearly to the ground at the break and lost his rider.
