SUNLAND SOUVENIR squeezed and checked at the break, was settled, just off the rail on the turn, fanned out some for the drive, altered out four wide for a clear path midstretch, closed well and got up in time. BRAVE JULIAN soon had the lead just off the inside, was challenged from both sides on the turn, moved clear into the lane, was under a steady drive but could not hold off SUNLAND SOUVENIR. ITS THE GOOD LIFE bumped from the rear shortly after the start, raced in contention from just off or along the rail, swung out on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, gained second nearing the final furlong but hung in the late going. HILLBILLYHARLAN without early speed, advanced along the rail on the turn, fanned out behind ITS THE GOOD LIFE entering the lane, moved outside the latter upper stretch then and lacked a serious bid. MIGHTY TO SAVE hustled along between rivals, vied for the lead just outside BRAVE JULIAN on the turn, floated out some leaving the bend, could not keep up and gradually yielded the final eighth. TIZ SEXY a contender from outside on the backstretch, lost ground widest through the turn and had no late bid. FRONT SIGHT bumped and forced into SUNLAND SOUVENIR at the start, was also checked back, trailed, just off the rail into the turn, swung out to path five entering the stretch and had no rally. CREATE OLE broke inward, bumping solidly with FRONT SIGHT, progressed in traffic, moved to the rail for room into the bend, went for the lead leaving the turn but tired for the drive.
