ZEE BEST HENNYSEE was hustled along to vie for the lead inside, floated out a bit entering the lane, was all out, edged ahead inside the final furlong and was kept to task to the wire. HOLLYWOOD SPEED dueled for the lead from outside, angled in beside ZEE BEST HENNYSEE into the turn, drifted out to path four into the stretch, tried hard, did not have enough left in the gate going but was easily best of the rest. THE TURKINATOR bumped with HERE'S A CHANCE at the break, showed no speed from outside, three wide on the turn, angled in some entering the lane, altered out for a clear path going to the final furlong and caught HERE'S A CHANCE for third. HERE'S A CHANCE bumped with THE TURKINATOR at the start, dueled for the lead briefly between rivals, three and four wide taking the bend, proved no match for the top pair and slowly wore down the last eighth. BRH RUN raced in contention from inside on the backstretch but started to flatten out along the rail once on the bend. GENTLE SUNDAY broke inward and a bit slowly, showed no speed from inside, angled out for a clear path upper stretch but had no late bid. YONDERLY displayed early speed between horses but faded four wide on the turn. READY TO DEAL came out slowly and throwing his head, was soon settled, showed little and had to be vanned off.
