SMILING REUBEN forced out some at the break, gradually angled in as he vied for the lead from outside, did not keep up into the bend, swung out six wide for a clear path entering the lane, drifted out upper stretch, was corrected, held a straight path the final furlong and got up at the wire. SWITHIN disputed the pace between horses from the beginning, was three wide on the turn, drifted out to path five into the stretch, fought gamely, lugged in through the waning yards and was narrowly outfinished. SQUAD LEADER soon vied for the lead just off the inside, was two wide taking the bend, battled through the stretch and was also narrowly outfinished in a very game effort. JUAN DE DIOS dueled for the lead from inside but slowly wore down the final furlong. KINDA SHINY broke outward, bumping solidly with BATTLE CREEK HIWAY, leaned on that one briefly, was prominent between horses on the backstretch but gave way from inside on the turn. NITETRAINTONOWHERE trailed from outside, was three wide into the turn, fanned to the middle of the track for the drive, lugged in midstretch and had no late bid. BATTLE CREEK HIWAY bumped solidly and forced into SMILING REUBEN just after the break, was steadied when the latter came in shortly after entering the main track, raced in contention between horses to the final quarter mile then gave way.
