JUSTA MILLION checked behind traffic shortly after the break, gradually moved in going to the turn, had the rail on the bend, swung out four wide for a clear path into the stretch, was all out the last eighth, closed strongly and finished on even terms with SUPER SWANK. The latter, steadied briefly behind RYXENA just after the start, quickly recovered to vie for the lead outside that one, came three wide into the stretch, gradually closed the gap on the leader and got her nose on the finish line in time. RYXENA showed first, set a pressured pace just off the inside, moved clear upper stretch, fought gamely the final furlong but was narrowly outfinished. GREEN TEA moved to the outside early on, failed to keep up while just off the inside on the turn, lost ground fanning widest for the drive, made a strong move deep stretch, came up short but was clearly best of the rest. SITIBY YOU moved toward the outside before finishing two furlongs, drew clear for third and took the rail on the bend then lacked the extra needed the last eighth. WEST OF ROME void of speed, though urged along, saved ground on the turn, floated out some for the drive and had no late bid.
