Footnotes

BLUE JACKET SAILOR bumped at the start, quickly moved clear, was challenged from inside nearing the bend, floated out some leaving the turn, moved ahead when asked upper stretch, was clear approaching the final sixteenth and held sway under steady handling. JOHN PEARL advanced along the rail to vie for the lead approaching the turn, slowly yielded in the lane but was unchallenged for the place. GEE EMINENCE bumped with GOLD WAGON at the break, raced in contention between horses, advanced three wide on the turn, fanned out six wide into the lane, altered in some for a clear path, took over third soon after and was easily best of the rest. LOGAN'S FLAG away slowly, rushed up from inside, swung out for a clear path on the turn, drifted out to path six for the drive and gradually faded. FROSTY SUPRISE soon trailed from between rivals, angled in on the bend, swung out to path four into the stretch and ran evenly. SWITHIN an early factor from outside, faded widest through the turn. GOLD WAGON prominent between horses, was steadied some as he tried to get out from between horses on the turn, came into the stretch from path seven, quit, was eased and walked off.
