Footnotes

FAIR MARKET VALUE was kept close just off the inside, waited for room along the rail on the second turn, got through two wide near the three-sixteenths marker, was all out, gained a narrow advantage approaching the sixteenth marker and held on under steady urging. SUMMERTIME SAL prominent between rivals, was two wide on the second turn, floated out one path entering the lane, drifted out a bit upper stretch, was corrected, had a slight lead nearing the furlong pole, fought gamely but did not have enough left through the waning yards. WILD UNION bumped after the start, was angled out on the first turn, gradually advanced running widest, lost ground taking the second bend four and five wide, dueled for the lead in the stretch but also did not have enough left inside the final sixteenth. SIMPLY SINNING trailed from inside, picked up his pace after a half mile, slowly angled out on the second turn, was six wide into the stretch, threatened with a furlong to go but leveled off instead. BIG JOHN BEAN bumped WILD UNION shortly after the break, soon had the lead from inside, showed the way in hand, was roused with a quarter mile left, all out through the stretch but gradually wore down. LUNCH BOX was forwardly placed three or four wide for more than six furlongs, began to back up entering the stretch, lost his path inside the three-sixteenths marker was angled in some and stedly faded.
