ARE YOU CRAZY was mid pack and closed on the outside going four wide for a driving finish. COWBOY'S KITTY made the lead on the rail, the rider lost his whip at the eighth pole and gave way late to hold on to second. LADY FOCUS broke slow and was hustled up on the inside, angled out at the quarter pole with a bid to get up for show. AL'S DOUBLE stalked the pace, two wide, but dropped back in the stretch drive. MID SUMMER'S HOPE was void of early speed on the rail and made a mild bid late. ZEE PROSPECT was mid field, three wide with no late run. TELLITTOTHEJUDGE was in contention early, three wide and retreated at the half.
