Footnotes

MONTH OF DIAMONDS prominent between horses from the start, advanced while four wide on the turn, fanned to path six for the stretch run, was put to a drive upper stretch, gained the advantage with a sixteenth left and gradually moved ahead through the waning yards. SUZIES PHANTOM disputed the pace from inside, was clear leaving the turn, floated out to path three for the drive, was all out, challenged from both sides inside the final furlong, could not hold off MONTH OF DIAMONDS but lasted for second under steady urging. HOLLYWOOD MISTRESS dueled for the lead between horses, was three to five wide taking the bend, came to SUZIES PHANTOM inside the last eighth, tried hard but did not have enough late. MERANDAS LEGEND vied for the lead between rivals, dropped back from close quarters just off the inside on the bend, swung four wide into the stretch, moved inside SUZIES PHANTOM approaching the eighth pole, came back to look a serious threat inside the furlong marker, hung some in the late going but was easily best of the rest. LANI'S EXCESS trailed, came into contention along the rail on the turn but could not sustain her bid through the lane. DIABLA displayed brief speed from outside, could not keep up with the pacesetters nearing the bend, angled in beside LANI'S EXCESS on the turn and was empty the last quarter mile.
