Footnotes

BLASTITARY vied for the lead two wide from the beginning, floated out some into the lane, fought between rivals and held MANOVAN at bay. MANOVAN bumped with SINGIN VICAR at the break, advanced between horses to vie for the lead three wide into the bend, battled gamely just outside BLASTITARY through the stretch but had to settle for second best. SINGIN VICAR bumped with MANOVAN at the start, progressed just off or along the rail, waited for room on the turn, gained a clear path two wide at the top of the stretch, split rivals with a furlong to go but could not close the gap late. EVANSVILLE VAN dueled for the lead from inside, tried hard in the stretch but slowly yielded inside the last eighth. KING GULCH prominent between horses, was three then four wide through the turn, altered out some for a clear path upper stretch but ran evenly the final furlong. BOLD COTORO in contention early toward the outside, was shuffled back into the turn, altered in to be just off the rail at that point, swung out to path six for the stretch run and had no late bid. HE'S A FLYER was a brief factor from outside, could not stay close while widest through the turn and steadily faded for the drive.
