Footnotes

LILS KING was hustled up from between rivals to engage MACK HENRY from outside on the turn, came two wide into the lane, soon took over the lead and steadily lengthened command under steady urging. KID CRAWFORD prominent outside SOUTHERN A LIST, found best stride deep stretch and swept past MACK HENRY for second in the waning yards. SIMPLE DEAL broke alertly, was quickly clear, engaged from outside on the bend, no match for SOUTHERN A LIST when set down for the drive and slowly wore down deep stretch. INDIES SPRING without speed from outside, lost ground taking the turn four and five wide, passed tired ones upper stretch then could only make up minor ground late. PACHE OF MELODY was also without early foot between horses, came four wide into the stretch and had no late bid. RED TAPPER was also between rivals early, angled in on the bend, checked along the rail as her path narrowed nearing the furlong marker, was altered out and lacked a significant response. GROOMS DUST BUSTER prominent from inside, was outrun into the turn, checked briefly behind TELL EM WITH EASE, angled out leaving the turn, had no stretch bid and was angled out again when SIR AFTER MIDNIGHT came out with a furlong to go. MEMAS SWEET RUN helped prompt the pace from between horses, angled in into the turn, failed to keep up just off the inside, lugged in under a right whip upper stretch and steadily gave way.
