Footnotes

ZAMNATION contested the pace from inside, moved clear into the lane, was roused upper stretch then gradually opened up under a mild drive. DIAMONDEXPECTATION was shuffled back and steadied near the half mile marker, blocked on the turn, got through three wide leaving the bend, fanned out to path five for the stretch run, took over second but could only lengthen his hold on that position late. CITY VOW trailed, picked up his pace along the rail leaving the turn and gained third late. INDIGO POWER raced in contention between rivals, was just off the inside taking the bend, had third with a sixteenth left but leveled off in the waning yards. PRESSTHEPACE quickly moved up between rivals to contest the pace, could not stay with ZAMNATION leaving the turn and gradually wore down between horses. IRISH LEXICON bumped with MISS NOGAL at the break, was an early contender from outside, began to back up on the turn, swung out five wide into the lane, altered in upper stretch and had no late bid. MISS NOGAL bumped with IRISH LEXICON at the start, was a brief factor just inside that one but faded two wide on the bend, altered outside the latter midstretch and had little left. MIKAY AS LADY displayed early speed outside, was three wide on the turn, gave way leaving the turn, swung out widest for the drive and continued to fade.
