Footnotes

NICK MISSED rated between horses early, progressed three wide on the backstretch, swung out to path six for room entering the lane, rallied under urging and got up in time. SOME FUN settled off the early speed, closed the gap four wide on the backstretch, vied for the lead leaving the second bend, came five wide into the stretch, battled on the front end just outside OMER'S SURE SHOT but could not hold off NICK MISSED nearing the wire. OMER'S SURE SHOT vied for the lead just outside DELATORE from the beginning, took the advantage three wide on the second turn, floated out some entering the lane, tried hard but slowly yielded inside the final sixteenth. REAL COOL JAZZ unhurried and soon well back, gradually picked up his pace while staying well off the inside, lost considerable ground fanning eight wide for the stretch run, closed well and narrowly missed third. SERVICE HAWK gradually angled out as he advanced on the backstretch, lost ground five to seven wide through the second turn and lacked the extra needed for the drive. DELATORE disputed the pace from inside, was just off the rail taking the second turn then flattened out the last quarter mile. CYBER BELL took the rail midway on the backstretch, was steadied in close quarters into the second turn, kept the rail and also wore down in the stretch.
