Footnotes

LIKA LYNX stalked from between horses, split rivals two wide to gain the lead on the bend, floated out to path four entering the stretch, lengthened command under urging and continued to open up while ridden out the last eighth. ROLLSURFERGIRL moved off the inside midway on the backstretch, advanced just off the rail on the turn, fanned out behind LIKA LYNX entering the stretch, fought for second and shook free for that position late. SKYZAAM'S HUNTER in contention just off the inside, gradually swung out through the turn, came five wide into the lane, fought between horses for the place, did not have enough late but was clearly best of the rest. LETHAL PROSPECT an early factor from outside, faded four wide on the turn, swung to path six for the stretch run and only passed tired ones late. TRAVELIN JONES set a pressured pace from outside, was overtaken while three wide on the turn, drifted out past the middle of the track entering the lane and only passed some tired ones deep stretch. SHEPACHE prominent from inside, could not keep up leaving the turn, floated out some into the lane, fought for second upper stretch then gradually faded.
