Footnotes

JAC CADILLAC rated from outside, angled in nearing the half mile marker, saved ground through the second turn, went for the lead in the lane, gained a narrow advantage nearing the sixteenth pole, dug in and held ROYAL REGENT at bay. ROYAL REGENT closest to the early speed from inside, lost ground swinging outside the leader at the top of the stretch, rallied from path five, battled gamely the final sixteenth but did not have enough left. PERFECT HEAT broke alertly, was wide taking the first turn, drifted out further entering the backstretch, drew off from the rest, stayed well off the inside taking the second bend, drifted out again into the lane and gradually wore down between rivals. STORMY PAL kept close to the second flight from between horses, closed the gap some three wide on the second turn, swung widest for the drive and found best stride too late. SECURITYSNIGHTMARE chased from between rivals, was just off the rail on the second turn, backed up some as he swung out behind ROYAL REGENT leaving that bend, altered in some for a clear path upper stretch but gradually yielded. CALL ATTENDANT steadied when she lost her path into the first turn, trailed from inside, angled out midstretch for a better path but lacked a significant response.
