EVANSVILLE VAN showed first, moved clear just off the inside on the backstretch, floated out to path three for the drive, was all out deep stretch and narrowly held on. BIG KISS forwardly placed between horses, swung to the outside entering the second turn, lost ground five then six wide through that bend, lugged in some under nearly all hand riding, came up a bit short but was clearly second best. DEVIL UP TO DATE advanced widest on the backstretch, took over third three wide on the second bend, fanned out some for the drive, had every chance but could only just hold his position late. HASTY CONCEPT settled, gradually progressed just off the inside, altered out to the middle of the track upper stretch, drifted out further, held a straight path the last eighth and was closing in for the show. MEDICINE CREEK bumped at the start, trailed toward the outside, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn, fanned to path five for the stretch run and could only make up minor ground late. JOHN PEARL prominent toward the outside, was two then three wide taking the second turn, began to yield leaving that bend, altered in for a clear path upper stretch and continued to give way. REEL AFFAIR bobbed a bit at the break, was steadied in close quarters along the rail as he vied for the lead inside EVANSVILLE VAN on the first turn, chased that one while still along the rail on the backstretch, gave way on the second turn and drifted out through the lane. FLEET CONTINENTAL broke inward, bumping MEDICINE CREEK, moved to the inside early on and proved empty for the stretch run.
