Footnotes

WYATT stalked the early speed from outside, closed the gap two wide on the turn, floated out to path four entering the stretch, took over just inside the furlong marker then steadily opened up under a drive. BARKER DOME bumped with UNO FRONTERA at the start, then was bumped by FERNANDO'S EGO, settled off the inside, angled in on the turn, swung out behind ALONG CAME THE CAT into the lane, altered outside that one upper stretch, was all out the last eighth, could not close the gap on the leader but caught FERNANDO'S EGO for the place. FERNANDO'S EGO broke inward, bumping BARKER DOME, quickly recovered and moved clear, saved ground through the turn, was no match for WYATT inside the last furlong, began to wear down some in the waning yards and was outfinished for second. UNO FRONTERA flipped as he was being led out of the paddock, was bumped at the break and forced inward, without speed, though hustled along, advanced just off the rail on the bend but leveled off the last quarter mile. SOLITARY THINKIN chased while toward the outside, lost position four wide on the turn, floated out to the middle of the track for the drive and lacked a significant response. ALONG CAME THE CAT broke alertly, was urged along from inside but could not stay with FERNANDO'S EGO, gradually angled out through the bend, came four wide into the stretch and flattened. DICK'S DANCER an early factor between horses, faded three wide on the turn. FIRST FRONTIER soon trailed running widest, stayed wide through the turn, lugged in upper stretch and had little to offer.
