SILVERS ROYALTY gradually angled in as she contested the pace, had a narrow advantage two wide leaving the turn, moved clear when asked upper stretch, was all out inside the final eighth and held PRINCESS HAILEY at bay. PRINCESS HAILEY rated from outside, was three wide into the bend, fanned to path five for the stretch run, took over second nearing the sixteenth marker, closed well but too late. HUBCITY LADY could not get her footing briefly at the start, trailed between horses, swung to the outside leaving the bend, came six wide into the stretch, steadily made up ground and got up for third in the waning yards. COOLMON KITTY showed first, was soon in the second flight not far off the inside, two then three wide taking the turn, lacked the extra needed for the drive but was clearly best of the rest. JULIEANNA B well placed inside on the backstretch, gradually faded once on the turn. KERCHINK KERCHINK steadied briefly when SILVERS ROYALTY took her path shortly after the start, was soon taken inside, saved ground through the bend and had no late bid. SEATTLE SHEBA disputed the pace inside SILVERS ROYALTY, had the rail on the turn, could not stay with the latter upper stretch and tired the final furlong.
