**Footnotes**

PALOMA MESA broke awkwardly, advanced from outside, was four wide through the bend, lugged in some as she gained the advantage upper stretch, soon moved clear and maintained full control under a mild drive. LA RULETA broke in stride, showed the way between rivals, in paths two and three taking the turn, was crowded and forced in some as she lost the lead upper stretch, no match for PALOMA MESA, moved outside that one with a sixteenth left and lasted for the place. ZENA AVENUE bumped and forced into QUAIL TRAIL just after the break, was an early contender from inside, angled two wide for room on the turn, was blocked upper stretch, moved out to path four then could not close the gap as she battled to hold third the last furlong. OUR LIL BROWN JUG broke inward starting a chain-reaction of bumping, pressed the early speed from inside, lacked the needed stretch bid, fought to keep third, did not have enough late but was clearly best of the rest. SNOWBALL SMARTY bumped solidly and forced into INTUITIVE at the break, was without early foot, improved position just off the inside on the turn, fanned four wide entering the stretch, angled out a bit as ZENA AVENUE came out nearing the furlong marker then finished evenly. SHE'S SPECTACULAR broke outward, pressed the pacesetter from just outside, failed to keep up leaving the turn, fanned to path five and slowly yielded. QUAIL TRAIL bumped after the start, was void of speed from inside, saved ground through the bend and lodged a mild bid to improve position in the stretch without threatening. SISTER ERICA without speed between horses, was three and four wide taking the turn, altered out to the middle of the track upper stretch and lacked a significant response. JUDITH'S MONARCH in contention between horses on the backstretch, faded four wide on the turn, fanned out further entering the lane, started to alter out with three-sixteenths left, was checked off INTUITIVE'S heels, continued out once clear and had little to offer. INTUITIVE also bumped solidly and forced into another at the start, was a briefly factor between horses, swung to the outside on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and steadily faded. ASHLEY'S IN DEMAND broke slowly, was soon far back and showed little.
