Footnotes

SIR SMART shared the early lead between horses, backed up some three wide nearing the bend, lost some ground fanning outside NATURAL DREAMS entering the stretch, was all out and caught that one at the wire. NATURAL DREAMS advanced from inside to gain the lead just after two and a half furlongs, was clear nearing the half mile marker, came off the rail some while being challenged from outside on the turn, floated out to path four entering the lane, shook free again, battled gamely deep stretch but had to settle for second best. KANWIN SO MUCH moved up quickly just off the inside to share the lead, did not stay with NATURAL DREAMS nearing the turn, went to the latter from inside on the bend, had every chance through the stretch but lacked the extra needed. SHOWTIME DON checked behind traffic midway on the backstretch, angled out four wide to advance on the turn but ran evenly through the lane. CALL TRANSFER pressed four wide on the backstretch, altered out some as SHOWTIME DON came out on the turn, was five wide entering the stretch and had no late bid. ARCHIE'S DREAM was an early factor from outside but steadily faded while widest once on the turn. THE RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
