AGGIE COLEMINER stalked from outside, took over as he floated out some entering the lane then slowly opened up under steady urging. HOWARD'S NO SAINT settled outside, angled in entering the turn, fanned out three wide into the lane, was forced in with three-sixteenths left, rallied too late the last eighth but swept past SURVIVING THE ODDS for the place in the waning yards. SURVIVING THE ODDS moved up between rivals to gain the lead, showed the way just off the inside, was challenged leaving the bend and slowly yielded along the rail in the lane. BATTLE CREEK HIWAY forwardly placed between horses, followed AGGIE COLEMINER on the turn, lost ground fanning outside that one into the stretch and lacked a late bid. COLLEGE GETAWAY a step slow at the break, advanced from inside on the backstretch, swung out through the turn, came into the lane behind BATTLE CREEK HIWAY, angled in some then lugged in with three-sixteenths left, was corrected but continued inward as he tired deep stretch. TRICKY RETURNS without speed, though urged along just off the inside, angled outside on the turn, was widest entering the stretch and had little to offer. CRYPTO RULER displayed early speed from inside but gave way on the turn. POP ROD loose briefly behind the gate, was reluctant to load once taken back to the gate, void of speed from outside when the race start, angled in some leaving the bend and was empty for the drive.
