Footnotes

BRAX rated between rivals just off the early speed, was caught in path four on the turn, carried out past the middle of the track into the lane, took the advantage inside the final furlong and drew off under a drive the last sixteenth. YVETT'S MAAR moved up quickly from between horses to gain the lead, showed the way inside his closest opponents but well off the rail, was in path three on the bend, drifted out to the middle of track entering the stretch, was no match for BRAX inside the last eighth but was unchallenged for the place. SUAVEY without speed from inside, was just off the rail on the turn, also drifted out entering the lane, came into contention as he began to drift out upper stretch and continued to drift as he battled to keep third in the late going. ONE BELL OF A BULL prominent from outside, was five wide on the bend, lost consider ground fanning widest for the drive, fought for third, was forced out some deep stretch and missed the show. ULTIMINIO R. leaned on the gate briefly and left it a bit awkwardly, trailed from outside, stayed wide through the turn, altered in after SUAVEY crossed his path midstretch and lacked a significant response. GET UP TAYLOR void of speed between rivals, was in path three taking the turn, carried wide staying clear of SUAVEY entering the lane, altered inside when the latter began to come out upper stretch and gradually faded.
