EVENING TO HIGHLIT rated first from outside then between horses, moved clear when asked two wide leaving the bend, was challenged from outside upper stretch, slowly drifted out under left-handed pressure from the three-sixteenths marker to the final sixteenth, was corrected and held ROLLPIRATEROLL at bay. ROLLPIRATEROLL prominent from inside, angled out for a clear path midway on the backstretch, was three wide through the turn, moved clear for second upper stretch, gradually angled out as EVENING TO HIGHLIT came out through the lane, did not have enough to get by the latter in the waning yards but was easily second best. TEHUANTEPECER was taken inside early on, had the rail on the turn, floated out behind ROLLPIRATEROLL entering the lane, lugged in with three-sixteenths left, was steadied behind PRINCE PAUL, gained a clear path while still along the rail soon after and caught the latter for third nearing the wire. PRINCE PAUL broke inward and it appeared his rider lost his whip early, moved up quickly between rivals to contest the pace inside EVENING TO HIGHLIT, had the rail through the turn, could not keep up leaving the bend, came off the rail some approaching the furlong marker, fought gamely under a hand ride to hold third but did not have enough left. A GHOST BY CHOICE forwardly placed outside, began to yield widest leaving the turn.
