FOREST COAST vied for the lead outside from the early going, was four wide taking the bend, battled through the stretch and edged ahead of KING GULCH nearing the wire. KING GULCH sent to contest the pace between TANGO MANGO and FOREST COAST, came three wide into the stretch, had a slight advantage with a furlong to go, was all out but had to settle for second best. MR. PINDTER (MEX) in contention from outside, improved position five wide through the turn, took over third upper stretch, could not close the gap on the leaders the last eighth but shook free for the show. HOPETOWN HERO in the second flight between rivals, was crowded and forced out some midway on the bend, angled in near the quarter mile marker, moved out to path four upper stretch and lacked the extra needed. B TEAM without early speed, was widest through the bend and was gradually closing the gap after straightening in the lane. LEESTOWNS FINALE disputed the pace inside his rivals, began to tire along the rail into the turn, tried to angle out in traffic midway on the bend and steadily faded from between horses. ATLANTIC THUNDER a bit slow into stride, was a factor from outside on the backstretch but tired four wide on the turn. TANGO MANGO displayed early speed just off the inside but flattened out the last quarter mile. HIS SONG was away slowly then showed little in a ground-saving trip.
