Footnotes

TO TERATAKI a step slow and throwing his head at the break, advanced from outside to vie for the lead four wide on the turn, fanned out some entering the lane, moved clear upper stretch and held sway under steady handling. BENTLEY'SBROWNHOSS prominent toward the outside from the beginning, was three wide into the bend, lost considerable ground when swung to path seven into the stretch, took over second nearing the furlong marker, had every chance the last eighth, lugged in some late and could not close the gap. IM THE PREACHER steadied when his path narrowed shortly after the break, was angled in looking for room shortly after that, checked while boxed in behind traffic from the five-furlong marker until nearing the half mile pole, was still boxed in behind the leaders on the turn and as he swung out five wide into the lane, altered out to path six for room upper stretch, moved clear for third inside the last sixteenth and was altered in trying to stay clear of BENTLEY'SBROWNHOSS in the waning yards. DOUBLE JOY contested the pace between horses, was three then four wide taking the turn then gradually yielded in the stretch. FULL OF ACTION vied for the lead just off the inside, took the rail into the turn, also weakened for the drive and was gradually drifting out in the waning yards. FLAPS displayed early speed between FULL OF ACTION and DOUBLE JOY, floated out some entering the stretch and also did not have enough left. QUADS TIME in contention between horses, improved position some just off the inside on the turn, lacked a stretch rally and was steadied some behind FULL OF ACTION nearing the wire. JUST FOR A MOMENT showed first, was soon outrun and chasing while toward the outside, was widest through the bend and flattened out for the drive. SANDIA SPEEDWAY gradually backed up from between rivals, was three then four wide through the turn and had no late bid. NICKI'S WINSTON broke in the air, showed no speed from between

horses, followed SANDIA SPEEDWAY'S path through the bend, lacked a rally and lugged in deep stretch. GOLD SWEEP was away slowly, stayed well back while never far off the inside and had little to offer in the stretch. EASY JACK also away slowly, rushed up to press the leaders from inside, quit along the rail on the turn, distanced himself from the rest through the stretch and was walked off. THE FIVE-FURLONG FRACTION WAS HAND TIMED.
