SEATTLE SHEBA showed first, contested the pace just off the inside, moved ahead some on the turn, was all out the last furlong and held off ALWAYSSTHESAMEOLINE. The latter soon angled in beside SEATTLE SHEBA as she vied for the early lead, came into the lane from path three, tried hard under a steady drive, did not have enough late but proved clearly second best. NO BLISS broke in some at the break, was steadied slightly, trailed from outside, advanced behind PAT'S PROSPECT on the turn, swung outside that one leaving the bend, was carried out to path six into the stretch then slowly closed the gap as she battled for third. PAT'S PROSPECT in the second flight toward the outside on the backstretch, moved clear for third from path three on the bend, drifted out five wide entering the lane, fought to hold hr position but did not have enough late. CHILLUM was a contender from inside early, failed to stay close along the rail on the turn, floated out to path three for the drive, responded to urging to duel for third midstretch but weakened inside the final sixteenth. LUCKY PICK a factor between horses on the backstretch, gave way two wide on the turn.
