### Footnotes

FANNY CHENAL soon had the advantage between horses, moved clear just off the inside on the turn, was engaged from outside midway on the bend, drifted out to path five while being urged entering the stretch, shook free again, drifted out inside the final sixteenth and was snatched up and altered in just before the wire. MILITARY MOTHER moved up from inside to vie for the lead nearing the five-furlong marker, backed up some along the rail on the turn, floated out to path three for the stretch run, came back to regain second and threaten midstretch but could only hold her position late. AMY J tried to bear out after breaking on top just out of the gate, was quickly corrected, backed off the front end after a furlong and a half, made her bid three wide on the turn, lost ground staying outside FANNY CHENAL into the stretch, lacked the extra needed for the drive and narrowly held third. CONGAREE DANCER was away slowly and settled at the back, picked up her pace three wide on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning outside AMY J into the stretch, closed well but too late. MERANDAS LEGEND was also away slowly, raced in contention two to four wide for more than a half mile but tired in the lane. THE RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
