Footnotes

HEAT SOURCE prominent between horses from the beginning, gradually angled in as he went for the lead into the bend, soon gained the advantage just off the inside, floated out to path four entering the lane, drifted out under left-handed pressure upper stretch, was corrected then steadily opened up under continuous urging. SPARK THE HUNT advanced between horses, was three then four wide taking the turn, altered out as HEAT SOURCE came out upper stretch, gained a clear path nearing the furlong marker, battled for second in the late going and prevailed. KINDA SHINY in contention from outside, followed SPARK THE HUNT on the bend, swung out widest for the stretch run, fought the latter for the place in the late going but did not have enough late. FLAPS forwardly placed between horses, was caught in tight as he vied for the lead nearing the bend, gained the rail on the turn, floated out some into the stretch, was no match for HEAT SOURCE and gradually wore down inside the last furlong. FIRST FRONTIER soon gained the advantage, gradually drifted out going to the turn, was collared near the bend, forced in entering the turn, began to fade two wide, drifted out into the stretch and continued to give way. ICED prominent on the backstretch, gradually retreated while angling out taking the turn and had little to offer for the drive. RON'S REJECT steadied in traffic shortly after the start, moved up quickly from inside to prompt the pace but began to tire leaving the turn. CLEVER PUNCH soon backed up from between horses, saved ground taking the turn and was empty for the stretch run.
