Footnotes

BIG KISS settled, advanced from outside on the backstretch, gained the lead three wide on the second turn, was clear entering the lane, lengthened command under urging upper stretch then continued to open up while ridden out the last furlong. BOLD MEETING settled outside, angled in on the backstretch, picked up his pace after a half mile, battled for second along the rail in the stretch and pulled clear late. PACHE ECHO STAR rated between rivals, was bumped nearing the end of the first three furlongs, gradually progressed, vied for the lead two wide on the second turn, was no match for BIG KISS, fought to keep second in the lane but did not have enough left the final sixteenth. TEJANO TROUBLE moved to the outside on the backstretch, was three wide on the second turn, carried out to the middle of the track entering the stretch and improved position widest without threatening. EVANSVILLE VAN boxed in on the backstretch, altered out near the five-furlong marker, jostled briefly with PACHE ECHO STAR, was just off the rail into the second turn, forced out to path six for the stretch run and lacked a significant response. ZARB'S HOT FRIEND threw his head at the break, quickly recovered to vie for the lead just outside PERFECT HEAT, could not keep up after three furlongs, gradually angled out through the second turn, came five wide into the lane and slowly yielded. PERFECT HEAT soon gained the lead and the inside, moved clear on the backstretch, was overtaken from outside on the second bend, came off the rail some entering the stretch and gave way.
