KEDDY KAUFAYE rated just off the leaders from between horses, gained the advantage two wide on the turn, moved clear leaving the bend, responded to urging upper stretch, steadily opened up and finished in hand as much the best. WESTERN SPIRIT boxed in behind the early speed, forced his way out midway on the backstretch, was four wide on the turn, backed up some leaving the bend, was in path three entering the stretch, split rivals with a furlong to go and pulled away for second late. SECURITYSNIGHTMARE prominent between horses, was crowded midway on the backstretch, altered in nearing the half mile marker, saved ground through the turn, was blocked with three-sixteenths left, altered out soon after and steadily improved position five wide. T SMITH contested the pace from along or just off the rail, could not stay with KEDDY KAUFAYE leaving the quarter pole and slowly wore down inside the final furlong. SPORTSCAST vied for the lead outside KEDDY KAUFAYE, also was no match for that one leaving the bend, came into the lane from path four, battled for second, his rider lost the whip inside the furlong marker and he slowly yielded. MARQUETRY CAT was an early contender from outside, lost ground taking the turn four and five wide and failed to have a significant stretch bid. WESTERN SHERIFF a step slow at the break, trailed just off the inside, angled out some on the turn, came into the lane from path four, altered in for room at the three-sixteenths pole and had little to offer. BABY ROBBER void of speed from outside, angled in to be just off the rail through the bend and proved empty for the drive.
