SOME FUN boxed in behind the early speed on the backstretch, got through three wide midway on the turn, came to MIKEY TOO from outside upper stretch and shook that one off the final sixteenth. MIKEY TOO stalked the pacesetters from just outside, made his move two wide on the second turn, was clear leaving that bend, tried hard to hold off SOME FUN in the lane but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. MINT MOHITO broke outward, was settled at the back just off the inside, picked up his pace on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the second turn, drifted out when put to a left whip nearing the furlong marker, was corrected, tried to drift out again under left-handed pressure in the late going but was easily best of the rest. WHOS LAZY contested the pace from inside for nearly five furlongs then began to fade. DEPOT RED shared the lead two wide from the early going, moved ahead nearing the second bend, took the rail into that turn, could not stay with MIKEY TOO near the quarter pole and gave way from inside through the lane. WILDINTHEWILDWEST was away slowly and failed to menace in a wide trip.
