HEARING VOICES was soon clear, showed the way from inside, floated out some into the lane, was put to a drive midstretch and maintained full control. BANDONTHELOOSE settled outside, picked up his pace four wide on the turn, fanned out to path six for the stretch run, was all out and got up for second late. WILLY JO HUNTER in contention from outside early on, did not stay close three wide on the bend, swung five wide for a clear path into the stretch, rallied with BANDONTHELOOSE from just inside and was narrowly outfinished for the place. INDIES SPRING raced closest to the pacesetter from just outside but wore down the final sixteenth. TANKA WINE without early speed, had the rail on the turn, fanned out to path three for the drive, started to alter outside INDIES SPRING nearing the eighth pole, was steadied briefly, altered inside instead and only made up minor ground the last eighth. RAMOUR was a factor from inside on the backstretch, gained third just off the rail on the turn, swung out to path four into the stretch then steadily gave way. BIG BRYCE was soon far back, though hustled along, stayed off the inside taking the bend and lacked a significant stretch bid.
