DELA'S DIAMOND never far back outside rivals, came four wide into stretch when making bid, responded to steady urging in drive to prove best in final stages. IGOFAST dueled outside rivals from start, gained slight nod into lane, was no match for winner in late going and settled for second best. QUI SPENDER gained early advantage along rail, dueled to mid stretch, weakened. MAITLIN never far back racing between rivals, lacked response. MISS SKI MO trailed early, raced five wide into lane, faltered in drive. BOB'S EGO dueled along rail to stretch, gave way. MITO WAY between rivals early, showed little thereafter.
