Footnotes

DISTORTED DANCER prominent between horses from the beginning, gained a slight lead two wide on the turn, fanned out some for the stretch run, moved clear under urging upper stretch and was kept to urging until the waning yards. LOGAN'S FLAG away somewhat slowly, advanced from outside, lost ground four then five wide taking the bend, took over second midstretch, had every chance at the winner the last eighth but could not close the gap. GONE JET in contention early between rivals, was just off the rail on the turn, fanned four wide entering the lane, altered out to path six for room with three-sixteenths left, could only make up minor ground late but moved clear for third. SUSPENDTHEBORDERS prominent toward the outside from the beginning, went for the lead three wide on the turn, fanned out further into the stretch, did not have enough left and lugged in late. HAMONCITO without early speed, was in tight quarters between rivals into the bend, advanced three wide, swung out behind SUSPENDTHEBORDERS entering the lane, progressed to the last eighth then finished evenly. FULL OF ACTION also void of early speed, was four then five wide taking the turn, altered out some for room with three-sixteenths to go, came out again when his path was taken nearing the eighth pole, improved position until the inside the final furlong then leveled off. HEARTBREAK BOY bumped with FLAPS at the start, chased from between horses, was also in tight briefly entering the bend, was just off the inside with a quarter mile left, swung out some for the drive, advanced to the last eighth and also finished evenly. FLAPS bumped with HEARTBREAK BOY at the start, soon trailed, was just off the inside taking the turn, fanned out some for the drive then gradually altered out looking for room as he passed some tired ones. SCHEMIN N DREAMIN displayed early speed inside, steadied some when his path was but gradually faded along the rail once on the bend. GOLDEN EXCUSE set a

pressured pace between rivals, angled in entering the turn, floated out some into the stretch and gave way. SISTER GUMP showed first, vied for the lead briefly, was steadied near the half mile marker, checked hard as she tried to get out into the turn, was allowed to drift when clear shortly after that and steadily faded.
