COWBOY'S PRAYER bumped with MR. VALENTINO shortly after the break, was hustled to the front then showed the way between horses in hand, lengthened his lead staying off the rail on the turn, roused upper stretch and moved to the rail, was kept to a mild drive until the final fifty yards then finished in hand. GO EMMITT GO a step slow at the start, was gradually angled out on the backstretch, three wide on the turn, swung out to path six for the stretch run, rallied and got up for second late. TO TERATAKI made a small awkward leap at the start, moved up from outside, four then five wide through the turn, battled for second after entering the final furlong but did not have enough nearing the wire. TRICK SHOT advanced between horses, bumped slightly with MR. VALENTINO near the half mile pole, weaved his way in to have the rail with three furlongs left, came off the inside some entering the stretch, gave futile chase and drifted out some as he slowly wore down inside the last sixteenth. SHE'S COOL AS ICE showed first but was soon chasing COWBOY'S PRAYER from outside, three then four wide taking the bend, was caught in tight quarters inside the last eighth and finished evenly. GRAND DECREE in the second flight between rivals, was just off the rail on the turn, fanned out some for the drive, fought for third brushing several times with SHE'S COOL AS ICE, did not have enough in the late going and was steadied when his path narrowed nearing the wire. ANZIGER hustled along from inside, was checked when his path was taken into the bend, continued along the rail, fanned out some for the drive, altered out to path three upper stretch and lacked a significant response. MR. VALENTINO bumped with COWBOY'S PRAYER shortly after the break, bumped with TRICK SHOT when caught in close quarters near the half mile pole, was two wide into the turn, backed up as he swung out leaving the bend, was five wide into the lane, altered out to the middle of the track with three-sixteenths left and had no late bid. BLUE JACKET SAILOR a factor just off the inside on the backstretch, failed to keep up two wide on the turn, continued to fade in the stretch and travelled the last furlong in hand.
