Footnotes

REEL AFFAIR was sent clear, drifted out to path four entering the backstretch, was challenged while just off the inside entering the second turn, floated out to path four into the stretch, felt the whip twice midstretch and edged ahead while ridden out the final furlong. DEVIL UP TO DATE kept close, also floated out entering the backstretch, went for the lead while four wide into the second turn, fanned out some for the drive, was on even terms, gradually drifted out the final furlong and had to settle for second best. ANGEL OF THE WIND prominent from inside then outside the first half mile, was three wide into the second bend, checked solidly when she lost her path at the quarter pole, swung outside REEL AFFAIR into the lane, lugged in behind that one as she gained third after entering the final eighth, was altered out some at the sixteenth pole and could only make up minor ground. TROUBLE RULES advanced from outside on the backstretch, jostled briefly with ZARB'S HOT FRIEND nearing the second turn, lost ground four to six wide through that turn, threatened midstretch but slowly yielded in the late going. CAPTAIN BUCKO without early speed from between rivals, had the rail into the second turn, came off the inside some leaving that bend and wore down the last furlong. ZARB'S HOT FRIEND fractious in the gate, was an early contender between horses, jostled with TROUBLE RULES nearing the second turn, moved to the inside on that bend, closed the gap but gave way the final eighth. The rider of ANGEL OF THE WIND lodged an objection alleging interference from REEL AFFAIR leaving the second turn. After their review, the stewards did not uphold that claim.
