Footnotes

PESCADERO rated in midpack, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn, angled out further for a clear path leaving that bend, battled under urging, gained the advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and began to shake free in the waning yards. EVANSVILLE VAN sprinted clear, showed the way just off the inside, drifted out some under left-handed pressure upper stretch, tried hard but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. LUCKY SOUL settled inside, angled out on the second bend, came five wide into the lane, steadily improved position, could not close the gap on the top pair the last eighth but bested the rest. STORMING SEA without early foot, picked up his pace just off the inside on the second turn, swung four wide into the lane, moved to contention upper stretch but leveled off in the late going. CALL TRANSFER soon trailed, commenced his bid along the rail on the second turn, altered out for a clear path after entering the last furlong and improved his position without threatening. MANOVAN in the second flight early, made his move three wide on the second bend but could not sustain his bid through the lane. TOVAR void of speed from outside, was in path three on the second turn, swung out six wide for the stretch run and passed some tired ones. ONE TOUGH HOMBRE chased the pacesetter from inside for six furlongs then began to flatten. PATHBREAKING progressed from not far off the inside to the second bend then gave way. YIELD A WINNER steadily faded from between horses, took the outside into the second turn and continued to retreat.
