PAISANO CREEK was guided immediately to the rail to track the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half, switched out leaving the far turn to race five wide into upper stretch and produced a sustained response to take charge late under firm hand urging. RIMINI REBEL, caught in tight quarters at the start, made steady progress three deep to gain striking distance on the far turn, couldn't match the winner in the drive but continued gamely between foes to prevail for the place. OUR CHAMPION, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to lodge a four wide bid racing through the far turn, struck the front in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. BADGER BO tracked the leaders along the rail as part of the second flight to the far turn, shifted out of close quarters entering upper stretch bumping SO BUSTED, then continued to make some mild progress between foes. TOO MANY SINS was urged to the fore from the break, angled over dictating the pace to upper stretch and gave way. SO BUSTED ducked outwards at the start, was a bit rank under some restraint racing into the first turn, moved to press the leader racing into the far turn, was bumped in upper stretch and soon gave way. COOL LION tracked the pace between foes in second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out of close quarters to race four wide into upper stretch but had no further response.
