Footnotes

STRADIVINSKY broke sharply, forced the pace outside a rival racing to the bend, angled inwards to dictate terms on the bend, forged clear nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. MANEKE was held up stalking the pace along the inside racing just off the leaders, came through inside a rival leaving midstretch and secured the place. CUBAN MISSILE, in close attendance to the pace along the inside, was held up a bit while relinquishing the lead entering the turn, chased the leader into upper stretch while shifting out a bit and weakened in the drive. COOL C NOTE worked his way to the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch and made some belated progress. HAPMAN broke inwards bumping HOLD THAT BROAD, was righted to track outside a foe in second flight, chased the leaders on the bend into upper stretch and faded in the drive. TRYING BRIAN tracked the pace outside foes four deep to the bend and never gained contention. HOLD THAT BROAD, bumped at the start, was settled into stride but never mounted a serious challenge. MAJOR RHYTHM, slow into stride, trailed the field to the lane.
