### Footnotes

MY MAN JAY was guided to the rail while gaining a contending position just inside the pacesetter in the opening quarter, made a steady advance to challenge that foe leaving the turn, shifted outside that foe in upper stretch and prevailed late under firm handling. AIR DAKOTA broke sharply, sped clear while angling to the inside racing to the bend, opened a commanding advantage after a half, resisted the winner to the end but came up second best. PHIL THE THRILL shifted off the inside early, made steady progress outside foes three deep to upper stretch and continued to close the gap on the leaders. BISCUITS N BEER chased just outside the pacesetter into the turn, but lacked the needed response in the last quarter. COMMANDER EVIL tracked the pace between foes in second flight, but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. FAST DEPOSIT stumbled at the start, was collected but never menaced thereafter. LOVE ALASKA threw his head at the start while breaking awkwardly, trailed the field throughout, then was vanned off the course after the race.
